### Why buy local?

Our national economy pays farms only about \$0.16 for every dollar consumers spend on food. When you buy local food directly from the farmer, the farmer gets the full amount of your purchase.

- Supporting local food means adequately funding our farms for all their time, money and effort.
- When farms are viable, they stay in operation and provide us with food as well as the open landscapes we enjoy.
- Local purchases reduce long-distance transportation and packaging of food, an ecological win.
- And when we buy locally, we are investing in our local economy, keeping these funds in-state.



### **Farmers Markets**

One way to purchase local foods is to visit one of the local farmers markets. Here you'll find vegetables, fruits, meats, honey, maple syrup, yarns, herbs and herb products, home baked breads and treats, local crafts, as well as a dinner selection often made with local foods. Apart from the great foods there is a musician providing entertainment, and a chance to see neighbors in this leisurely setting.

### **Local Food Affordability For All**

The Jericho, Richmond and Essex Parks & Rec Farmers Markets accept 3SquareVT/SNAP benefits and can supplement purchases through the Crop Cash and Crop Cash Plus programs. For each \$1 spent at the farmers market, you receive extra money to spend on local fruits, vegetables, herbs, and culinary seeds and plant starts. Markets will match up to \$20 of your SNAP benefits per day.

Example: If you were to spend \$10 of SNAP benefits at the market, you would get \$10 of Crop Cash (for fruits/vegetables) and \$10 of Crop Cash PLUS (for SNAP-eligible items). That's a total of \$20 extra dollars to spend at the market!

### Local Access to Food

### **Community Food Sharing Sheds**

These are structures built by community members where neighbors can share home grown food. The food sheds rely on home gardeners supplying extra vegetables, fruits, and plants for anyone to use. They are open during the summer season and provide easy access to free food. Visit them often because the types of food available varies each day. There are 3 in our 2 towns: Jericho Center near the Community Center, Underhill Center across from the Town Hall, and Underhill Flats off Park Street behind the United Church of Underhill.

### **Food Shelf**

A local food shelf can be a reliable source of food for both small and large families, usually operated by local churches. Our local food shelf gathers goods donated at churches, at local grocery stores, and purchases through the Vermont Food Bank. The groceries include a wide variety of canned, fresh, and high protein foods. You can register at the monthly

### **Federally Supported Food Programs**

- 3Squares VT also known as Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, SNAP/EBT (formerly known as food stamps). This program helps limited-income individuals and families buy the food they need. www.vtfoodbank.org/access-food/3squaresvt/
- Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) Vermont Food Bank administers this program that provides food for people over 60. (It is currently taking names for the waiting list). 1-800-214-4648

**NOFA Farm Share Program** - Provides financial assistance to people looking to purchase a farm CSA. When you sign up for a CSA at a farm, you pay in advance for a portion (or "share") of the farm's upcoming harvest and receive a regular box of farm-fresh food all season long. The NOFA Farm Share Program provides Vermonters financial assistance for CSA shares reducing the cost by 25-75%. It allows Vermonters to access more healthy, local food while ensuring farmers are fully compensated for their work. Some individual farms also offer farm share financial assistance for CSAs.
